Undergraduate and graduate courses in all subjects.


(Some courses with special requirements are upon lecturers' permission.)

Semester Program

- Non-Chinese-speaking exchange students are eligible to take "semester program" (group class) for up to 6 hours per week without tuition.
- For students who want to take courses other than "semester program" or more than 6 hours per week, a 20% discount of standard tuition will be offered.
- "Record of Study" will be provided when reaches course requirements.
- Non-compulsory, no credit provided.

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Visa Requirements	 For One-Semester Exchange Student Study LESS than 6 months: VISITOR VISA; then apply for extension within 15 days before the duration expired. For One-Academic-Year Exchange Student Study MORE than 6 months: RESIDENT VISA; then apply Alien Resident Certificates (ARC) within 15 days after arrival. 			
Medical Insurance	All exchange students are required to purchase both overseas <i>Accidental Insurance</i> & overseas <i>Medical Insurance</i> . Each kind of insurance shall worth a minimum of NT\$1,000,000 (approx. US\$33,000) valid for the entire exchange period. From the 7th month of the stay, students are required to join National Health Insurance (NHI) of Taiwan according to the laws.			
Living Costs in Taipei	Meal: NTD100~200 per meal Transportation: MRT-NTD20~65, BUS-NTD15~45, TAXI-from NTD90 Off-campus Housing: from NTD9,000 per month			

Applicant Eligibility

- Full-time students nominated by NTNU's contracted Partner Institutions
- Have completed at least 1 year of university work prior to participation in exchange
