The teaching language of every course is stated in the curriculum. In case of doubt, you can ask the lecturer in charge of the course, or the corresponding Departmental Coordinator. Even if a course is taught in Catalan, students can use Spanish to communicate with the lecturer, to write essays, and to sit for exams.

Deadlines	<u>First semester</u> - Receive nominations no later than June 15th - Fill in application form no later than July 1st - Send documents required no later than July 15th <u>Second semester</u> - Receive nominations no later than November 15th - Fill in application form no later than December 1st - Send documents required no later than December 15th
Visa and residence permit	<u>Visa and entrance in Spain</u> European Union citizens: valid passport and/or identity card.
